Maths - Money

Focus: Counting money and 1:1 correspondence

Today we will introduce Money to the children, please watch the video posted onto Class Dojo where Miss Abbie will teach the children about money.

First, talk to your child about the video.

What did you see?

Have coins and notes available for your child to touch and look at in real life. (Please do not focus too much on exact value - the children are exploring money)

Show your child different types of money (paper and coins) What makes them different?



Using only 1 dirham coins:

Put 3 coins on the table, can you count the coins? How many coins are there?



<p>Literacy - People who help us: Firefighters</p> <p>Focus: Drawing and writing sentences</p>	<p>Today we will be learning about firefighters. Please watch the teaching video posted on Class Dojo by Miss Emily.</p> <p>Firefighters are people in the community who help us. There are lots of ways they can help us.</p> <p>Here is the link to the 'imagine that' video about becoming a firefighter. You might like to watch this before your child begins their activities.</p> <p>https://youtu.be/YQqglFvn7gU</p> <p>First, you will dress up as a fire-fighter. How do firefighters help us?</p>	

Can you help the people in your community?
Who will you save today?



Next, complete the activity in your home learning pack.
Draw a picture of a firefighter helping someone. What shapes will you use? What colour will you use for the fire engine?

Then, think about writing your sentence. What will you write?
Remember to look at your picture to give you an idea. Say your sentence out loud and count how many words you need to write. Keep repeating it to support writing.



Here are some examples of what your child might like to write:

He can stop the fire.

They can save the cat.

The fireman rescued the people.

A firefighter can put out the fire.

Encourage your child to use capital letters at the beginning of a sentence, finger spaces in between words and a full stop at the end.

Super challenge: Can you write on the line?

Please remember this is your child's own work, it does not have to be spelt perfectly. We like to see them using their phonics skills to spell words.

<p>Maths - Money Focus: Counting with coins</p>	<p>Today we will be learning about Money. Please watch the video posted onto Class Dojo by your class teacher.</p> <p>First, you might like to listen to the counting to 20 song, encourage your child to sing along: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Aq4UAss33qA</p> <p>Recall yesterday's learning with your child and show them a 1 dirham coin.</p> <p>What is this coin? 1 dirham</p> <p>Practice counting quantities and matching dirhams to number cards.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">   </div>	

	<p>Continue to count different amounts of coins and match to number cards 1-10.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you count and match quantities to 12?</p> <p>Complete the activity in your home learning pack: Count the dirhams in the wallet. Can you match it to the correct toy from the shop? Which toy is 8 dirhams? How many dirhams do you need to buy the duck?</p> <div data-bbox="1522 324 1837 682"> <p>Count the dirhams in the wallet and match it to the correct item from the toy shop.</p> </div>
